Highlights of discussion: Goal A – clarifying O & A Committee's role with coalitions: Action: Annette and Linda will generate a separate doc with the brainstormed ideas.  Goal B -Website has been launched; continuing improvements underway; list of coalitions posted; and, resource docs to be posted this summer. Social Media - the Alliance's lane is policy not to provide services to youth via social media, that is being done through other orgs. Actions: Annette will continue to work with U of O to clarify type of scan happening around the state. Kimberlee suggested templates for safe messaging for use on social media.  Goal C – Ryan suggested Alliance connect locals to national resources via Alliance website; Annette suggested leveraging existing resources rather than creating new one.
