8:30 AM	<p>Welcome, Announcements and May Minutes</p> <p>David Westbrook</p>	Opening comments	<p>Annette welcomed participants and acknowledged the current intense situation of the Black Lives Matter protests throughout the state and nation. She shared that it is a time for Hope, Health, Healing and transformation. Current events are informing us and that we can all do better. Members shared similar thoughts and feelings.</p> <p>Galli noted this article about the high suicide rate among black teens: https://theconversation.com/black-kids-and-suicide-why-are-rates-so-high-and-so-ignored-127066</p> <p>LauraRose shared the link to Peer Galaxy, a support network for individuals with lived experience: https://www.peergalaxy.com/</p> <p>Don moved to approve minutes; Galli seconded. Motion passed</p> <p>Annette – The group convened to talk about shared messaging in response to proposed budget cuts to behavioral health services.</p>

			<p>She provided a summary of the initial meeting, key take-aways are: in service to the Children’s System of Care, collaborate on shared messaging about the importance of maintaining services; agencies/departments need to pull together rather than working against one another to maintain funding; a meeting with lobbyist from various organization would be helpful for crafting shared messages; and, a second planning meeting will be held soon to chart a course of action.</p> <p>Meghan Crane: The Alliance may want to consider touching base with Oregon Coalition of Local Health Officials (CLHO), especially if we are looking at shared protective and risk factors including ACEs, substance and alcohol use, violence prevention, etc.</p>

Annette did report the Alliance website is currently down due to it transitioning from UO to AOCMHP for ongoing management and maintenance.</p>

9:45	<p>Legislative and Advocacy Agenda</p> <p>David Westbrook</p>	<p>Review and Discuss Draft Policy Agenda</p>	<p>David – we are four years in on implementation of the YSIPP. Let’s think about where we started and where we’re headed to guide our discussion on the Legislative agenda/priorities. David provided a brief summary of milestones (SB 707, funding for training, staffing (OHA and Alliance) increased awareness/interest in suicide prevention, SB52, etc.),</p> <p>Don – there has been an intense focus on investment; we need to make the case for a big return on small investment re: suicide prevention. This is not a time to retreat – the current environment points to potential increase in suicide due to the pressures and risk people are experiencing.</p> <p>Jill – it is interesting that law makers who in the past may not have focused on suicide prevention are now interested. Currently</p>

			<p>there is no mandate for an adult suicide prevention plan like there is for youth.</p> <p>John – other states have plans that focus suicide prevention across the life span. It is important for OR not to lose the youth focus.</p> <p>Debra - is researching plans from other states and how they are set up (single plan across lifespan or separate for adult and youth but integrated).</p> <p>Action: Debra will summarize her findings and send to David, Galli and Annette for circulation.</p> <p>David – add a legislative recommendation that OHA have an adult suicide prevention plan similar to the YSIPP. Have accountability built into the plan and a strong collaborative tie to the youth plan but not necessarily an integrated plan.</p> <p>Ryan – suggested the addition of promoting an adult plan be added to the policy agenda under “explore” category.</p>
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			<p>Next steps: Full membership to review/comment on the policy agenda at the June quarterly meeting (small group activity) prior to adopting.</p> <p>Action: Full membership to vote on adoption of policy agenda at the June 2020 quarterly meeting.</p>
