- 1. Lines for Life will work with ODE on suicide prevention website content.
- 2. AOCMHP will provide a cost estimate to expand Connect statewide. Evaluation of Connect pilots will be conducted by U of O and recommendation for expansion statewide will be through the Evaluation & Data committee.
- 3. Lines for Life will take the lead on the Youth Suicide Prevention Summit, with advice and recommendations on speakers from the Alliance.
- 4. The Shift project is incorporated into a Behavioral Health Collaborative recommendation and Lines for Life will reassemble the Shift group to seek non-governmental funding.
- AOCMHP will ask the School Safety Task Force to make a recommendation to each ESD to connect students with crisis resources when necessary, and to include an appropriate youth crisis 24-hour service contact on all students' (grades 6-12) identification cards.
- 6. The Shift project is incorporated into a Behavioral Health Collaborative recommendation and Lines for Life will reassemble the Shift group to seek non-governmental funding.
- 7. Lines for Life will take the lead on initiating the Communication Directors workgroup and identify members who may participate.
- 8. Research on support resources and groups action was moved to Adhoc Consulting.
