12.31.2020	Task 3	<p>Monitor progress on systems issues identified in spring 2020 by TOC related to implementation of HB3090, 3091 and HB2023 (note-there is a detailed plan in place that will be reviewed with new TOC members and modified if needed)</p> <p>Progress: Letter sent from Committee and Alliance to Rep. Keny-Guyer noting concerns with "Implementation of Oregon Administrative Rules developed under ORS 441.015 to 441.063 (HB3090) and ORS 441.196 (HB2023)" and outlining nine stakeholder entities engaged with the process and recommending a process for addressing these concerns. Next Steps: Soon after this letter was sent, Jerry Gabay, one of the key advocates working on this issue, died and Covid-19 pandemic shifted legislative and public health priorities. The Transitions of Care Committee will meet this summer to re-engage with this issue.</p>
