9:06	Discuss next steps for Committee and HB 2315 implementation		<p>Next step is the Rules Advisory Committee and we want a couple folks to join this. We also want to work to have the healthcare sector to have similar requirements. We should spend this next year to develop allies within the healthcare sector and discussing language around what should be in the bill.</p> <p>We should send names of folks we want on the RAC to Jill. Effective implementation of HB 2315 will also be an in-depth project. OHA may be the ones in charge of assigning folks to RACs. Length of the RAC will depend on the specific bill. Stephanie was on one that lasted over a year. Stephanie was nominated to be on the RAC by Julie. We also want to have youth / young adult representation on the RAC.</p> <p>Considerations to think about when proposing healthcare:</p>

			<p>-Timing – healthcare may be really burnt out after year of COVID.</p> <p>The more we can tie suicide prevention CEUs into burnout and suicide rates among healthcare professionals, the better for our work. Oregon Medical Association (OMA) is a support of suicide prevention work and has adjusted some of their work to be more trauma informed.</p> <p>Rep. Reynolds is a member of OPS and can be a great ally in our work.</p> <p>Sarah wants to do a scan to see what is needed / wanted by the workforce and appreciates Kirk’s comment to frame the CEU legislation for healthcare folks as a way of supporting them.</p>
