8:30	<b>Welcome Members, Announcements</b> Justin Potts and Claire Kille	Introduction of new members or participants (highlight in chat)	Claire and Justin led the group through introductions.

Claire and Justin have stepped in to help with co-chairing this group and we need to do an official vote as a committee.</p> <p>Annette led the group through a consensus vote to approve Justin Potts and Claire Kille as chairs for the committee with Justin Potts serving on the Executive Committee as the schools rep and Claire as proxy when needed.</p> <p>Huzzah – they have been voted in!</p> <p>Annette shared that our previous co-chair, Kimberlee Jones, passed away this previous Saturday. 8:50	<p><b>YSIPP Initiative Review and Updates</b> Jill Baker</p>		<p>Historically, the YSIPP was built out as a 5-year plan. This time, the plan has a framework and is broken up in 1-year pieces so that partners involved in the work can see what they would like to work on on an annual basis. A set of priority initiatives was set in the middle of 2021 for 2021-2022 calendar years.</p> <p>This fall, we are going to take a look at the initiatives that we said were the priority, assess where we are at with progress, ask ourselves if these are still the good next steps for 2023, and ask what we want to stop, start, and continue. What did we think was a good direction that isn't working and should be stopped? What language needs to be adjusted to better reflect what we are doing / should do?</p> <p>Jill is asking committees what initiatives we still have on our workplan, are they things we want to continue, and if we want to continue them, what will they look like? Jill is asking</p>

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			<p>for committees to do this process September and October, send decisions to her in November, and the final ones will be decided in December.</p> <p>Annette created some tables that look at all YSIPP Initiatives and how they connect to Alliance Committees that can help to guide this discussion and decision.</p> <p>Annette shared that we will probably have our primary / priority initiatives that we specifically focus on and there are other initiatives that we have said we wanted to stay informed on.</p>
9:10	<p><b>Committee Communication Tools</b> Justin Potts</p>		<p>Justin shared options around communication tools. See attached meeting materials for more details.</p>
9:20	<p><b>Adi's Act Scan Results</b> Justin Potts, Claire Kille and SSPW Team</p>	<p>Impressions, Opportunity for Committee input and Engagement</p>	<p>See attached meeting materials for details on the Adi's Act Scan results from the SSPW team.</p> <p>Angi thinks that the Adi's Act required policies need to be reinforced and described as living documents and not as a one and done situation. Her district has changes that they have already seen that they</p>

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			<p>need to make and the process to repost / update the posted policy is slow which can add a barrier. She has noticed that training for staff is low and wonders if this committee can advocate at a state level for professional development time and if the findings from this scan would help us to advocate for this.</p> <p>Claire agrees with Angi and says, “How do push the message that this is a living document? This work is always improving and adjusting based on a school's community and culture. What ways can we as a committee, OHA, ODE, SSPW teams be sure districts are hearing the importance of this?”</p> <p>Mila shared that, when there is a requirement through a policy such as Adi’s Act, there needs to be funding attached to it for schools to implement it. It can be difficult for people that don’t understand school schedules and staff availability to understand why funding needs to be attached but without it, they can’t accomplish these things even when they identify it</p>
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is something they want to do. Money would be used for things like substitute teachers and covering staff time to complete trainings like those required through Adi's Act. Mila also shared money to have someone regularly update their website which relates back to the Adi's Act requirement. They can post their policy once but when there are updates, it may not be updated on the website as they don't have someone staffed to provide website updates.

Mila also shared that adding in the intersection of BIPOC student needs adds a whole other level of barriers as schools need to be able to have screenings and other suicide prevention related documents into other languages so that they are accessible and equitable.

Multiple people said that it would be helpful to have a rubric for Adi's Act implementation.

Annette reminded us that our role as a committee is to monitor and advise. It is helpful

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			for us to develop a strategy for how to do this moving forward.
