This may help it have a smaller fiscal impact.</p> <ul data-bbox="898 971 2018 1049" style="list-style-type: none"> • Language from One Pager: Increased access to accurate and accessible training on suicide assessment for health professionals <p data-bbox="898 1105 1793 1141">Suicide Prevention Training for Medical Providers (LC 1237)</p> <p data-bbox="898 1149 2039 1414">This bill will require OHA to identify or develop and implement training options for medical providers. Medical providers need continuing medical education in suicide assessment, safety planning, and treatment. We are asking OHA to ensure that medical providers have access to effective trainings with a goal of increasing the number of practitioners that take this training as measured in SB 48 (2017). More than 60% of people who die by</p>

		<p>suicide have seen a healthcare professional in the month prior to their death. The National Strategy for Suicide Prevention concludes that equipping doctors and nurses with accurate information about how to identify and support a suicidal patient is one of the most effective ways to prevent suicide.</p> <p>Bill language suggestion from Cheryl: something stronger than a list made available and pointing people where they can go to get training as this isn't making a training available. She would hope that we are creating / implementing something for providers to use.</p>

Question from Jill: As you may remember, OHA has contracted for the development of an online 3 hr course in suicide prevention that will meet HB2315 requirements for the Traditional Health Workers workforces. I am looking for someone to serve on the curriculum oversight committee for this project (to review the curriculum, give feedback, etc). As agreed, I saved one spot on that group for the Alliance's workforce committee. The person will receive a \$500 stipend for their efforts. The expectations and timeline are attached.

Updates from Jill:

HB2315 implementation efforts:

- Rules went live Jan 1st
- 3 hr suicide prevention training – paid for by Problem Gambling
 - For traditional health workers
 - Online, on-demand, free of charge
 - Jan – Aug development timeline
 - **Looking for an Alliance rep to serve on THW (Traditional Health Workers) curriculum advisory (\$500 stipend).** First meeting starts in February and there will be a Doodle poll going out to schedule them. Final meeting may be in July. If more than 1 person is a good fit, we can keep talking about that possibility.

- 3 hr suicide prevention training for Spanish speakers

Suicide Prevention Related Workforce Training report (formally known as SB48 report):

- Approved by leadership, Comms, and gov't relations
- Submitted to Publications with a rush request
- Includes recommendations for medical providers to receive training + recommendation for well-funded evaluation to assess appropriate trainings by provider role

Spanish speaker training will be provided in Spanish.

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Follow-Up Tasks for HB 2315	<p>Updated Rules from Jill, Plan for TSPC engagement, Priorities for Jill: RAC then co-create a scope of sequenced recommended trainings by role followed by RFP.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. RFP development advice for training (Don, Stephanie, David) Requested feedback from folks within 2 weeks on materials she sent to folks. 2. Co-create a scope of sequence of recommended trainings by role (Don, Cheryl C., Sarah) Staff to-do to help bring this meeting together with Jill & Shanda. Should be concurrent with RAC. 3. Review Rules to Determine RAC Need (Annette, Jenn and Stephanie) Rules around Traditional Healthcare workers (that OHA has control over) – these were updated but did not include suicide prevention. There needs to be a rules advisory council for this and Jill thinks she needs to ask for emergency rules process to make sure they are in effect in time. Stephanie, Annette, Marielena, Jill to meet. Timeframe – Jill will get back to the group on a timeline. Guess is to meet within the next couple of weeks. Stephanie says between now and March 31st and not May works for her. <p>OAR 410 – Jill thinks these need a RAC OAR 309-027 – Jill does not think that these need a RAC</p>
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
