8:40	Updates / Announcements		Family Acceptance Project: The Alliance and OFSN applied to ODE for an LGBTQ+ Student Success Act Grant and received one to train folks on the Family Acceptance Project which looks at how do we cross the cultural divide that happens around the support of LGBTQ+ folks. How do you support parents who may have beliefs that fundamentally opposes some of the needs of the LGBTQ+ community? How do you help them to support their kids? This spring, 4 trainings were provided in SW Oregon. More than 200 people signed up and 130 participated. There will be a report sharing feedback from attendees on what kind of support they need to support LGBTQ+ students and their families. Annette offered a presentation by Caitlin Ryan in a future meeting if committee members are interested. The group is waiting to hear if they will receive funding for another year and, if they do, they will provide trainings on the Western part of the state.
