		Lethal Means priority area with OFSC
		- HB 3513 from the 2023 session would have created specific
		program for firearm hold agreements so that people in a
		suicidal crisis can give their firearms to a trusted 3 rd party in a
		locked state so it couldn't be used and not have it count as a
		violation in the law. Right now, there is a very narrow carveout
		for who guns can be given to in times of a crisis.
