| 8:40 | Announcements and Updates | Note updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adi's Act plan statewide – they are nearing 91% of school districts with an adopted policy. - Safe and Inclusive Schools team is recruiting for a school safety advisory group. Deadline for this has been extended. |
| | School Based Health Center Legislation Annette Marcus | <p>There is legislation going through this upcoming short session that would provide additional funding to school-based health centers and to increase mental health services. This bill was proposed in the 2023 long session but did not pass. Annette thinks this would be an important piece of legislation to support as the Alliance. Please expect more information to be shared in the future.</p> <p>The group held a discussion around what it could mean to have Adi's Act accessible and relevant to students with disabilities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Claire asked the group if anyone was involved with Disability Rights Oregon as they have a mental health advisory. This could be a place to connect with. - Jill said that OCUSP was done work on this and they have materials from their fall training. Kahae said that some Sources of Strength staff attended a training they hosted. - The resource Project Simple was shared with the group. - Suzie Stadelman and Dr. Geovanna Rodriguez and I (and others) also recently worked on a paper about the intersection of autism and suicidality |
