Membership and Stipends

Membership Requirements

- Attend three of four quarterlies
- Review specific OHA policies re professional workplace, discrimination, public records and privacy/security
- Complete 3 online trainings from DAS

Member Resignation or Removal

- Exec may recommend to OHA based on not meeting member expectations
- OHA director must approve
- Discrimination/Harassment follow state (DAS) policy

Stipends:

Clarity re: who qualifies for stipends (members) and types of activities



Terms, Subcommittees

Executive Position Terms

- Chair, 2 years
- Vice-chair, 2 years vice-chair (rotates into chair position)
- ▶ Elected positions, up to 3 years
- Sub- Committee Chairs, confirmed annually by subcommittee. No limit
- Add option for tribal rep

Subcommittees

- Elect co-chairs
- Members self-select into subcommittees
- Forward recommendations to exec for approval

Advisory Workgroups (as needed)

- Comply with public meeting law
- No voting



Decision Making

- Votes require a quorum
- Quorum for Executive and Full Alliance defined as 50% of members + 1, must include chair or vice-chair
- Quorum for subcommittees 3 voting members, must include chair or vice-chair of subcommittee
- OHA members can vote (but may choose to abstain

- Executive committee has authority to recommend appointment and removal of members
- Executive committee may make time-sensitive recommendations to OHA between quarterly meetings



By-Law Changes: Clarification

- Made clear that the Oregon Alliance to Prevent Suicide is the same as the YSIPP Advisory Committee (per SB707)
- Made changes getting the Alliance's statutory authority consistent with the bylaws (recommending legislative priorities, etc)



Unresolved by Task Force

- Task force recommends removing OHA positions from the Executive Subcommittee, due to being voting members
- Task force did not come to consensus on whether we need to define "at-large member".
