- **Discussion about Be Seen, Be Brave-SUD**
 - Group discussed the training being developed with Be Seen, Be Brave for Substance Use Disorder. Donna-Marie and Amanda shared their experiences with BSBB as they both have taken the trainings to be trainers for BSBB-Mental health and BSBB-Suicide Prevention. Amanda also shared the link the creators have set up to gather feedback to help inform the accessibility of the language being used in the SUD training so it can be used for ages 14 and older.

 - Donna-Marie led the discussion of the various legislative measures and bills that had been part of the recent short session that would be of interest or impact to the Lethal Means subcommittee. This included an update of the Armory Project and the recent summit around safe storage.
